SCULPTED WALL PANELS INSTALLATION



Recommended Installer Qualifications: Only those parties experienced in working with finished fine wood products should engage in installing Sculpted Wall Panels

Recommended Installation Equipment: Tape Measure, Level, Chalk Line, Drill/Screwgun, Large Flat-Bladed Screwdriver, and Construction Adhesive

- Sculpted Wall Panels are supplied in factory-fabricated panels per provided Layout Drawing(s). If necessary, each supplied panel
 will be marked with a unique identifier in accordance with the identifier assigned per the Drawing(s). A copy of the Drawing(s) is
 included with the product shipment for reference.
- 2. In accordance with facility architectural drawings and specifications, locate and install Sculpted Wall Panels per Layout Drawing(s) and other applicable facility location drawing(s).
- 3. Lay out work to be completed, including all component parts, along base of substrate (wall). Check material for any damage that may have occurred during shipment and/or handling at job site.
- Establish a baseline at the proper location on substrate to ensure level installation.
 Note: Chalk line and reference marks may be visible after installation and must be removed at clean-up.
- 5. Begin at one end of the installation. If there is a restricted end due to a corner, door frame, or other obstruction, begin at that end.
- 6. Apply construction adhesive in a thorough and good workmanlike manner.
- Align first panel to the baseline. Install supplied Walldog™ anchors. Be sure to use each screw hole in each tab.
 Note: DO NOT over-tighten Walldog anchors.
- Align second panel to the baseline. Align tabs and slots and slide into place. Screw in place along the three other edges. Repeat
 this step for each panel.
 Note: There will be a slight, even gap between the panels to allow for expansion.
- Push the supplied Klick clips into each slot. Use either your thumb or a large, flat-blade screwdriver. Be careful if using the screwdriver to not damage the panel.
 Note: DO NOT install Klick clips before mounting the panel to the wall.
- 10. Align wood trim pieces with Klick clips. Trim pieces may require cutting to length.
- 11. Use your palm to press the trim piece onto the Klick clips until there is a solid click.
- 12. Clean with dry or slightly damp cloth. Touch-up panel finish where needed using supplied touch-up paint. Dab a small amount with a brush and rub with a clean, dry cloth.
