

**Description:** A non-woven fabric, composed of natural cellulose and synthetic fibers which has been treated with a chemical binder. It has dimensional stability, high MD stiffness and high wet and dry strength.

**Applications:** This heavy weight non-woven fabric is designed for application over rough or damaged, cracked or uneven wall and ceiling to provide a fresh base for painting, wall covering or other decorative treatments. Providing that the existing surface is structurally intact, properly prepared and sealed, this material can be used over wallboard, plaster, painted and wallcovered surfaces, as well as, cement block and paneling.

Because of the wide range of application, types of surfaces, textures, treatment, and other conditions beyond Koroseal's control, appropriate wall preparation products and adhesives will need to be selected to match each individual installation. If there are any questions, a test installation is advised.
